The volunteer will assist full-time therapists and employees of the Windmill Therapy Center in working with people with disabilities. The Therapy Center has seven working areas: housekeeping, carpentry, gardening, art therapy, handcrafts, tailoring and theater. The volunteer will assist disabled people in their daily work and rehabilitation, as well as the open air activities, trips and tours.

Tasks of the volunteers include:

- ▶ Help therapists in their daily work in the working areas;
- ▶ Help in preparation and assisting them in walks and tours;
- ▶ Organizing activities about volunteers' countries;
- ▶ Preparation and presentation of cultural elements of their own country;
- ▶ Preparation and participation at promotional campaigns of "Erasmus+";
- ▶ Preparation of an international market stalls with the intercultural games at various outdoor events, celebration and festivals.

Activities for children, youth and families

CKK “Wiatrak” is a non-public educational institution, focused on organization of non-formal and cultural activities for children, youth and adults. The Center is run by the “Windmill”. It realizes various educational activities, thematic competitions, meetings and special events.

The aim of the planned activities is to promote culture, revive the local society through the implementation of interesting educational and cultural proposals. Volunteers will prepare interesting games and workshops, teach their pupils basic phrases in their national language, and also implement their own ideas.

Tasks of the volunteer include:

- ▶ help in preparing and conducting classes, competitions, thematic workshops and interesting games for children and youth;
- ▶ help in preparing winter and summer breaks and camps for the children;
- ▶ help in some office work;
- ▶ preparing and organizing of international stand, activities, international games and giving a support during various outdoor events, festivals and concerts;
- ▶ assisting and being responsible for some local projects and initiatives (cultural events, exhibitions, sports competitions, meetings, etc.).
