



EVS - Volunteering&Sustainable Development II

When: 1.07-30.09. 2018 (long term – 3 months)

Where: Baia Mare (Maramures county/North of Romania);

Why: Volunteering & Sustainable Development II (VSD) aims to provide young people a framework for reflection on the importance of social, economic and environmental sustainability in a consistent manner as chapters of sustainable development. By participating in project activities, participants will gain knowledge about the environment and local communities from rural Romania. VSD II project promotes active involvement, dialogue and civic debates.

Who:

Target group: 5 volunteers (2 from Spain, 2 from Italy, 1 from Portugal).

Roles and task of the volunteer:

- to prepare activities and games for the Summer Camp Activities. Summer Camp Activities will be weekly (2/3 days a week) activities organized in two villages from Maramures county (Oarta de Sus, Asuaju de Sus) for the local children (aged 7-18), during August and mid September.
- to propose one weekly workshop (language and culture, food and traditions, handmade etc) for the local children
- to participate and help organizing the trips and hiking activities organized together with the local volunteers for the children from the local community
- to participate at the weekly coordinating meetings and mentorship meetings
- to write articles for Greentin's blog in order to promote the project and volunteering

Allowance:

Each volunteer will receive:

Food allowance – 120 euro/month

Pocket money – 60 euro/month

Travel:

In order to get in Baia Mare you can travel by:

- Plane:
 - the closest airport is in Cluj Napoca (Romania) (<http://airportcluj.ro>)
From Cluj Napoca to Baia Mare by bus (<http://www.fany.ro>) – price of one ticket is 40 Ron (Romanian currency) – which is around 8 Euro.
 - the airport in Budapest (Hungary) is another option;
From Budapest to Baia Mare by bus (<http://janositrans.ro/ro>) - price of one ticket is around 25 Euro;

For the travel cost we will be able to reimburse:

- up to 275 Euro – if you are coming from Italy;
- up to 360 Euro – if you are coming from Portugal;
- up to 360 Euro – if you are coming from Spain;
